#### COVID GUIDELINES FOR ST. MARY'S CHURCH

Mindful of the continuing significant outbreaks of the Corona virus throughout the country, we wish to draw your attention to the following guidelines for the celebration of the Eucharist in St. Mary's Church. In recent weeks there has been a significant increase in the number of people wishing to attend our week-end masses. This is especially evident at the two Sunday masses at 9am and 12 noon. To try and alleviate this situation and to welcome the people who might wish to attend we are putting on an extra mass.

# There will be an extra Sunday Mass at 10.30am each Sunday, starting on Sunday 20th September.

It is now strongly recommended that all those who attend mass on weekdays or Sundays should wear a face mask and we appeal for your co-operation in this matter.

We ask those individuals attending mass to please sit where it is clearly marked 'individual seating' and not to occupy a family seat.

A small number of people who attend the Vigil Mass on Saturday evenings are also attending on the Sunday. We would ask those concerned to only attend at one of the week-end masses.

It is still possible to fulfil your Sunday obligation by attending mass on week -days and we are happy that a number of people are following this guideline and thereby creating spaces in our church for those who can only be present at week-ends.

We ask all those attending week-end masses to please come on time in order to avoid disappointment as the 'Church Full' notice will be placed on the main door as soon as mass begins.

We thank you for your co-operation with our volunteers who are doing such an excellent job of stewarding at all week-end masses. We ask you to please be guided by them and show your appreciation for the assistance they are giving.
